We are very excited to announce a New Student Internship Program for Touch Ministry of Calvary Baptist Church, Morristown, NJ. We are looking for talented, self-motivated, energetic High School/College Students who are interested in learning about community service, event planning and fellowship.

Touch Ministry ministers to individuals in the church and community who have been impacted by HIV/ AIDS. We assist those who are living with the disease in finding agencies providing the services that they need. We offer prayer, counseling, support and love to persons with HIV/AIDS as well as their family members. In addition, we offer educational workshops and other events, which help to increase awareness and knowledge of HIV/AIDS and thereby reduce the spread of the disease.

Depending on placement, interns will help coordinate events, administrative duties, and assist in public relations for the Eric Johnson House in Morristown, NJ.Each intern's segment will run about 4 months. Interns will be expected to work a minimum of 10 hours a week. Internship hours may consist of attending monthly meetings, internet research, assist with event planning and attending church services/activities. Please note, depending on the weeks the intern is scheduled, hours and responsibilities are subject to change. All internships are unpaid with occasional non-monetary incentives.
