 - God's re-appropriation of the historical event (Acts 2:26)
 - God's eternal plan (Rev. 12:8)

A. The Financial Image

- Captives in a slave market or prison camp
- Payment is made for freedom
- See Mark 10:45, Roman 3:24, I Cor. 6:20

B. The Military Image

- The scene is a battlefield
- God and the devil do battle over a people. Christ is the warrior of God who achieves the victory in resurrection
- See Colossians 2:15

C. The Sacrificial Image

- The scene is a place of worship
- The guilty stand before God
- Christ is both Priest and Lamb
- See John 1:29
- Christ is the voluntary sacrifice John 10:17

D. The Legal Image

- The scene is a courtroom
- God as judge; people as guilty; sentence is death
- Christ takes the penalty himself
- Vicarious suffering I Peter 2:24, Hebrews 9:28
