 - Alienated from purpose (Ps.100)

- B. Estrangement from Environment (vv.7b, 14)
 - the previous state (2:9,15)
 - from enjoyment/care to consumption
 - from harmony to tension
- C. Estrangement from God (vv.8-10)
 - previous state (1:27,28, 2:7)
 - New state: distance, fear, conscience
 - Our condition in relation to God:
 - o Dead (Eph. 2:1)
 - o Lost (Eph. 2:13)
 - o Enemies (Eph. 2:16)
- D. Estrangement from each other (vv. 12,13)
 - previous state: unity and intimacy (2:24)
 - New state: blame, victimization
