Peace and the Word

Psalm 119:165, Isaiah 48:18

1. Relationship between the Word of God and Peace:

A. The Word of God establishes peace in our lives. There is a connection between our exposure to the Word and our experience of peace.

B. Psalm 119:165

- "Love of the Law" = "Great peace"
- Those who have "great peace" will not fall when they face obstacles.

C. Isaiah 48:18

 The Lord declares that peace will flow like a river when we "hearken" to his commandments.

2. What should be our relationship with the Word?

A. Appreciation: the child of God should value the word – Psalm 119:103, 131

- B. Confrontation: we are to encounter the Word through reading it and hearing it Psalm 119:130
- C. Meditation beyond initial encounter, there is continual pondering over the Word Psalm 119:97, Psalm 1
- D. Application this is the level of obedience Psalm 119:167, Matt. 7:24-27
