# The Epistle of Certainties: I John

## I. The Background

- A. Authorship very probable that the Apostle John is author of both Gospel of John and I John. (the same dualistic language)
  - author is possible eye-witness to the Christ-event (see 1:1-3)

#### **B.** Genre

General Epistle vs. Personal Epistle:

- is this letter written for a particular body or for the church in general?
- Compare this letter with I Corinthians

#### C. Audience:

- Somewhere in the province of Asia
- A congregation struggling with its beliefs.
- A "new" kind of teaching arises amongst the fellowship (probably some form of Docetism).
- Adherents leave the fellowship.
- Those left behind are in need of assurance. Hence the concept of "know" is crucial.

### II. Structure and theme:

A. Theme: God is light love life

God's character – should result in a particular way of living for believers.

- C. The Purpose of the Book
  - to add to their joy (1:4)
  - to guard against sin (2:1)
  - to warn them against false teachers (2:26)
  - to assure them of eternal life (5:13)
