<u>ntroduction:</u>
➤ Hardships of ministry bring death to Paul's mind.
What are some things which cause thoughts of death to arise?
➤ How does the Christian face these thoughts and realities?
➤ What are some truths revealed in this text?
 1. Beyond the grave we are clothed with glorified body (vv.2-4) This is Paul's meaning of the "tent" image.
There are 3 stages in this "clothing" metaphor:

- dead - unclothed

- alive - residing in the tent

- clothed upon/with - transformation of the body at the return of Christ.
