1. Contextual Considerations:

- 7:53-8:11 not found in the oldest Greek manuscripts. What does it mean? Authentic incident, but may be out of place. May not be a part of the original Gospel of John
- The dialogue/speech of chapter 8 is a continuation of the dialogue/speech in chapters 7 at the Feast of Tabernacles

2. Textual Truth – 4 Key Words

A. Abide (menō) – "if you continue..."

- denotes close, consistent contact and connection (see John 15:4)
- the believer is called to have consistent contact with the Word (see Psalm 1)
- Consistent contact with the Word always results in something

- the difference between disciple and members has to do with the response to the Word.
- learner and imitator. The teaching of the teacher becomes the basis for conduct.
- C. Truth (Alētheia) "and ye shall know..."
 - truth happens when appearance and reality match.
 - the "truth" her has to do with the saving knowledge of Christ. It is not general truth.
- D. Free (Eleutheroō) "and the truth..."
 - Free from fear
